SECTION II: The salaries of all officials and employees of the Borough shall be paid on a bi-weekly basis with the exception of those salaries paid *not less than quarterly* so as to conform with pension reporting procedures.

SECTION III: Each full-time employee, except for those employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement or a management contract shall receive longevity pay, according to and in compliance with the Borough of Longport Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual and Employee Handbook, in addition to their regular salary.

SECTION IV: Firefighters and Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) may receive a stipend. The Fire Chief shall develop criteria for payment of an annual stipend to certain Firefighters/EMT's of the Longport Volunteer Fire Department. Those criteria shall be presented to the Director of Public Safety and Public Affairs on an annual basis for the Director's approval. In no event shall any such stipend paid by the Borough of Longport in accordance with this ordinance be considered as salary or other remuneration. The payments set forth herein shall not be considered salary, nor shall such payments be considered to in any way construe the creating of a paid or partially paid fire department or ambulance squad with the Borough of Longport. No person receiving such stipend shall be considered by virtue of that stipend alone an employee of the Borough. Payments of stipends are subject to production of adequate documentation of current certification. No individual may receive fire department stipends totaling more than \$2000.

SECTION V: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

DIRECTING THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND THE ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS TO PERFORM NECESSARY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE LONGPORT POINT AREA

IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THE SAME LEVEL OF SHOREFRONT PROTECTION

TO THOSE RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS AS IS BEING PROPOSED

FOR THE OTHER RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Army Corps of Engineers has been authorized to perform a Shorefront Protection Project on Absecon Island supported by the State of New Jersey as the necessary means to provide storm protection specifically to the residents and property owners of the Borough of Longport; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport was one of the first communities after Super Storm Sandy to appeal to both the State of New Jersey and Army Corps of Engineers to have adequate shorefront protection established for the Borough of Longport; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of New Jersey has acknowledged that shorefront protection should be a state-wide concern and that all of the residents and property owners of the State should be adequately protected against property damage from future storm events; and

WHEREAS, in meetings with both the Army Corps of Engineers, N.J.D.E.P. Bureau of Coastal Engineering, and Stevens Institute of Technology, the Borough has requested and received assurances that the portion of the Borough of Longport known as Longport Point would be properly protected; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport has legally and properly removed all local impedances to the performance of a shorefront protection project and has worked diligently with the N.J. Attorney Generals' Office to identify and obtain the necessary easements to effectuate the Absecon island Shorefront Protection Protect; and

WHEREAS, a publication by the N.J.D.E.P. Division of Coastal Resources dated October, 1981 entitled New Jersey Shore Protection Master Plan identifies Absecon island as Reach 9 which limits are from the centerline of Absecon Inlet to the centerline of Great Egg Harbor Inlet; and further indicates the Borough of Longport as the only Category I Area (severe erosion portion) of the Absecon Island Reach 9; and

WHEREAS, the Army Corps of Engineers Absecon Island Project did not include the Longport Point Area in its Federal Authorizations as indicated in the Master Plan Publication; and

WHEREAS, due to this omission, a publication of the Army Corps of Engineers prepared for the N.J. Department of Environmental Protection issued in 1993 and entitled Longport, New Jersey Storm Protection and Beachfill Stability Analysis, which Analysis indicated five (5) Proposed Alternatives "that would provide increased storm protection and enhanced shoreline stability compared to existing conditions at Longport Point"; of which four of the Alternatives included modified beachfills and only one included a seawall; and

WHEREAS, at a Borough Meeting with the Army Corps of Engineers, N.J.D.E.P. Bureau of Coastal Engineering, and Stevens Institute, the Borough was directed to have a study performed to determine what, if any, modifications would be necessary to the Eleventh Avenue Groin and/or Atlantic Avenue Jetty in order to stabilize the intended Longport Point Beachfill that was directed to be performed with the Absecon Island Shorefront Protection Project; and

WHEREAS, the Borough employed at its own expense, a highly experienced and reputable Coastal Engineering Professional, Dr. Richard Weggel, PhD, P.E. who had previously performed several coastal design projects that were accepted by both the N.J.D.E.P. and Stevens Institute, to prepare a Report as to what structure modifications would be necessary, which Report was sent to both the Corps and Stevens Institute; and

WHEREAS, at a recent Borough Meeting with the Army Corps of Engineers, the N.J.D.E.P. Bureau of Coastal Engineering, and Stevens Institute of Technology, which meeting was requested by the Borough in order to coordinate the structure and beachfill work with the pending Absecon Island Project, the Borough was informed that there would be no commitment of a beachfill with the Longport Point Area; that the Corps would not permit any modification to the Eleventh Avenue Groin; that the N.J.D.E.P. would only consider the 'seawall' alternative; and that the State would commit no funds to the construction of said seawall.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Borough of Longport that it hereby objects to any Absecon Island Shorefront Protection protect that does not include adequate shorefront protection improvements to the Longport Point as it contradicts the intent and purpose of the Governor's directive that adequate shorefront protection be established along the entire coast of New Jersey; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, should this recent independent administrative directive issued to the Borough that the only administratively permissible measure of protection for Longport Point be a seawall, that the State of New Jersey authorize and fund under the State Shorefront Protection Fund of 75% State/25% Local, said seawall and include said construction within the pending Absecon Island Shorefront Protection Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Municipal Clerk be directed to serve a copy of this Resolution to the Honorable Chris Christie, Governor, Honorable Frank LoBiondo, U.S. Congressman, State Senator Jim Whelan, Assemblyman Vincent Mazzeo, Assemblyman Christopher Brown, and Commissioner Robert martin, N.J.D.E.P.

Mayor Russo explained the importance of this resolution and made motion to approve. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Leeds. ALL AYES-no oppose

Bill Pay List and Financial Report Summary

Read into record by Commissioner Lawler who also asked if there were any questions from the audience. Hearing none, Commissioner Lawler moved to approve the Bill Pay List and Financial report summary. Seconded by Commissioner Leeds. ALL AYES- no oppose
