Resolution to Extend 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2017 Tax Due Date

**WHEREAS,** delays by the State of New Jersey have delayed the issuance of tax bills for the year of 2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Longport in Atlantic County that pursuant to R.S. 54:4-67 the rate of interest to be charged for the non-payment of taxes and/or assessments on or before the date when they would become delinquent, is hereby fixed at eight (8%) percent per annum on the first \$1,500 of the delinquency and eighteen (18%) percent per annum on any amount in excess of \$1,500 to be calculated from the date the tax was payable until the date of actual payment, provided however, that no interest shall be charged if payment of any installment is made within twenty five (25) days after the date upon which the same became payable (August 1, 2017) with a due date extended through August 29, 2017.
