**ESTABLISHMENT OF AN EMERGENCY ‘NO PARKING’ AREA AND
OTHER EMERGENCY TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ON VARIOUS PORTIONS OF STREETS
DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2020 SIDEWALK INFILL PROJECT**

WHEREAS, The Contractor for the Borough of Longport, **Hackney Concrete, Incorporated** will be installing concrete sidewalks on various portion of roadways as listed below for the **2020 Sidewalk Infill Project**; and

WHEREAS, due to this construction a temporary condition exists necessitating special traffic regulations within portions of the Municipal Streets as listed below, including but not limited to, the prohibition of parking on both sides of said streets within the respective project zone; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:197.3, a Municipality has the right to permit special traffic regulations when circumstances of this type dictate its necessity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Borough of Longport that it hereinafter authorizes the temporary special traffic regulations, including but not limited to the prohibition of parking during actual construction activities, to be implemented under the direction of the Longport Police Department in the Borough of Longport, Atlantic County, New Jersey:

'No Parking' on both, or one side if so indicated, of

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prohibition of parking shall expire upon completion of the aforesaid project or ninety (90) days from this date of adoption, whichever is the sooner as determined by the Longport Police Chief.
