BOROUGH OF LONGPORT ORDINANCE 2016-18 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 144 "NUISANCES, PUBLIC HEALTH" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Longport, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that the Code of the Borough of Longport shall be amended to ADD the following sections;

§ 144-2. Use Restrictions C. Time Restrictions

The sprinkling or watering of a lawn or other plantings planted on a lot, with an exception for new sod, plantings, is limited to only one one-hour period for manual sprinkling and to only one fifteen-minute period per zone for automatic sprinkling systems during a stated twenty-four-hour period from May 15 through September 15 and as is hereinafter set forth:

- (1) Watering will be permitted on Monday, Wednesday and Friday for homes with an odd number street address.
- (2) Watering will be permitted on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday for homes with an even number street address.
- (3) No watering will be permitted on Sunday in any district during the period of regulation.
- (4) Any such sprinkling or watering must be confined to the period between 4:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. or 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.
- (5) The waiver of these limitations for new sod, plantings shall be for a period of not more than two weeks.

D. Suspension of watering rights during emergencies.

Nothing in this article shall be construed as preventing, in an emergency situation, a total suspension of the right of any person to the use of said water supply for any of the aforesaid purposes.

E. Construction of terms; responsibility for violations.

The term "person" in this article shall be construed to mean owner, landlord, tenant, employees and/or agent, and said "persons" shall be held equally responsible for violation of any of the provisions of this article.

Section 144-5 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES shall be amended to read as follows:

F. Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates the provisions of this article shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both such fine and imprisonment.
