

Whereas, it is in the interest of the Borough of Longport to designate guarded beaches from which persons may bathe and swim; Whereas there is an appropriate season to provide guarding services and further there is a need to provide a pre and post season lesser level of guarding as a function of weather conditions. In 2012, the guarded beach-bathing season is designate as commencing 6/16 and terminating 9/9. Weather permitting limited guarding will be provided on designated pre and post season weekends.


