

An Important COVID-19 Update for Longport Residents

Please note the following:

- All Municipal Buildings will close at the end of business on Wednesday, March 18, 2020, and remain closed until April 2, 2020 unless further closure is authorized by Executive Order of the Mayor. All services are still available at this time.
- You can continue communicate with Borough Hall Staff by phone at 609.823.2731, via email or regular US mail. A phone directory and email address listing is available online at www.longportnj.gov.
- There is a drop box at the main entrance of the Longport Police Department where any documents to be reviewed by Borough staff can be deposited including the payment of utility bills and/or taxes. Please specify which department your drop off should be referred and a return contact phone number, email address or mailing address if you require a response to your drop off. Payments may also be made online at the Borough's website: www.longportnj.gov.
- All Municipal Meetings including but not limited to Regular Commission Meetings and Planning/Zoning Board Meetings are canceled until April 2, 2020, unless extended by Executive Order of the Mayor. Social Luncheons are also canceled until further notice. Proper notice will be provided for Special or Emergency Commission meetings where Municipal business may be conducted.
- Municipal Court Sessions and Hearings are postponed until after April 20, 2020. Please call 609.822.2147 ext. 112 for more information or visit njmcdirect.com.
- The Longport Public Library is closed until further notice. Please return materials after the Library reopens. For more information regarding the Longport Library please visit www.longportpubliclibrary.org.
- Police, Fire and EMS service will continue as usual.
