1. Garden beds are available on a first come, first served basis.
2. Participants must maintain their beds for the duration of the season. Planting, weeding and harvesting is the responsibility of each gardener or group of gardeners. Gardens must be cleared out by October 31st of each year.
3. Gardening methods must be organic, no chemicals can be used.
4. Gardeners must provide their own tools and seeds/ seedlings. Some gardening tools will be available for community garden use.
