ORDINANCE NO. 2018-13**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 161 “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,”
SECTION 14.1 SCHEDULE 2A, “HANDICAPPED PARKING” OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF LONGPORT, ATLANTIC COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to make amend the Borough of Longport’s Code to reflect changes in Handicapped Parking Spaces Schedule 2A.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

SECTION I: Chapter 161 “Vehicles and Traffic,” Section 14.1 Schedule 2A “Handicapped Parking” of the Code of the Borough of Longport is deleted in its’ entirety and is replaced as follows:

“§ 161-14.1 Schedule 2A: Handicapped Parking.

A.

The following locations are hereby designated as restricted parking spaces for use by persons who have been issued special vehicle identification cards by the Division of Motor Vehicles. No other person shall be permitted to park in these spaces:

16th Avenue	West	Beginning at a point 43 feet south of the southerly curbline of Atlantic Avenue and extending to a point 19 feet south thereof
16th Avenue	West	Beginning at a point 62 feet south of the southerly curbline of Atlantic Avenue and extending to a point 20 feet south thereof
18th Avenue [Added 4-20-2016 by Ord. No. 2016-08]	West	From a point 15 feet north of the northerly curbline of Beach Terrace and extending to a point 40 northerly therefrom
20th Avenue [Added 4-20-2016 by Ord. No. 2016-08]	West	From a point 35 feet south of the southerly curbline of Atlantic Avenue and extending to a point 40 feet southerly therefrom

28th Avenue [Added 4-20- 2016 by Ord. No. 2016-08]	East	From a point 70 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Ventnor Avenue and extending to a point 40 feet northerly therefrom
22 North 34th Avenue	West	Beginning at a point 88 feet south of the southerly curblineline of Winchester Avenue and extending to a point 23 feet south thereof
3300 Atlantic Avenue	South	Beginning at a point 391 feet west of the westerly curblineline of 35th Avenue and extending to a point 22 feet west thereof
3400 Atlantic Avenue	South	Beginning at a point 131 feet west of the westerly curblineline of 35th Avenue and extending to point 26 feet west thereof.
32 North Evergreen Avenue	West	Beginning at a point 97 feet south of the southerly curblineline of Winchester Avenue and extending to a point 27 feet south thereof
2900 Longport Drive	South	Beginning at a point 19 feet east of the easterly curblineline of 29th Avenue and extending to a point 20 feet east thereof
3104 Ventnor Avenue	West of Woodcrest Avenue	Beginning at a point 39 feet south of the southerly curblineline of Ventnor Avenue and extending to a point 22 feet south thereof
28 South Woodcrest Avenue	West	Beginning at a point 80 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Pacific Avenue and extending to a point 20 north thereof
121 North Woodcrest Avenue	East	Beginning a point 279 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Winchester Avenue and extending to a point 23 feet north thereof
135 North Woodcrest Avenue	East	Beginning at a point 407 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Winchester Avenue and extending to a point 23 feet north thereof

B.

In addition to the penalty imposed for the violation of any of the provisions of this article of any vehicles parked in violation of any of the provisions of this article, the Police Department may cause said vehicle to be removed to such place as designated by the Chief of Police. The owner or operator of such vehicle so removed shall pay the reasonable cost and expense of such removal and the storage which may result therefrom, and any person, firm or corporation desiring to reclaim such vehicle may do so by paying the expenses of such removal, storage and violation.

C.

In addition to any other penalties herein provided, any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon the conviction thereof by the Municipal Court, be punishable by a penalty of \$100 first offense; subsequent offenses to be \$100 minimum and/or up to 90 days' community service.”

SECTION II: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies, are hereby repealed. Should any section, subsection, clause, or portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction as invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by Law.
