ORDINANCE 2023-29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 57 SECTIONS 18 and 19

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

Borough of Longport Code Provision Chapter 57 Sections 18 and 19, addressing alcoholic beverages in the Borough, is hereby amended as follows:

§ 57-18 Regulations.

[Amended 3-22-2017 by Ord. No. 2017-08]

No person shall, on any public or quasi-public property, in or not in a private conveyance, within the Borough of Longport:

- **A.** Consume any alcoholic beverage.
- **B.** Be in possession of an opened or unsealed container of any alcoholic beverage.
- **C.** The foregoing restrictions shall not apply to alcoholic beverages sold or sampled at the Longport Farmer's Market [or at Longport Borough special events] provided all applicable permits and authorizations have been obtained.

§ 57-19 Violations and penalties.

[A violation of Sections 17 – 19 constitutes a breach of the peace.] Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00 \$1,000.00 or a jail term in the county jail not to exceed 90 days 6 months, or both, at the discretion of the sentencing judge, and each day that the violation under this article shall continue shall be deemed a separate violation under this article.
